

The FORWARD Campaign

In March 2020, days before in-person classes were suspended because of the pandemic, the CCS Board of Trustees hosted a two-day workshop led by a biblical-based consulting group about the direction of the school. What came out of that workshop and the Together We Dream precampaign study later that year was a clear message that the CCS community would support a fundraising campaign. The first donation to the FORWARD Campaign was received in late 2020.

The FORWARD Campaign will conclude on December 31, 2023. As of September 30, we have received \$2,009,854, which is 63% of the campaign's \$3.2 million goal. Additional gifts to the campaign will increase the Central Fund which includes funding toward tuition assistance and will go toward completion of the school's parking lot and classroom projects.
